#### God is faithful and keeps His promises.

On November 15, 2021 our beloved pastor Barry Kendall went home to be with our Lord and Savior. He was not simply a friend or an acquaintance. He was our pastor and held a special place in our lives and in the life of the congregation. He was with us for a long time as Moses was with the Israelites.

In the 31st chapter of Deuteronomy Moses states, "I am now 120 years old and I am no longer able to lead you. The Lord has said to me, 'You shall not cross the Jordan.' The Lord your God Himself will cross over ahead of you. He will destroy these nations before you, and you will take possession of their land. Joshua also will cross over ahead of you, as the Lord said."

Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the presence of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you must go with this people into the land that the Lord swore to their ancestors to give them, and you must divide it among them as their inheritance. The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be *discouraged.*" (Deut. 31:7-8)

The past 16 months have been a time of uncertainty as it was with the Israelites. We haven't always seen or understood what was happening, but through faith and His promises God has walked with us and has brought us to this point in time.

Our members of the congregation have stepped up to fill the life of the congregation with hope, faith, prayers, actions, personal growth, and love. God has been faithful and has provided for us.

There will never be another Pastor Barry Kendall. We were very blessed to have had Pastor Kendall to guide and lead us on our spiritual journey. Remember and celebrate him and his gifts for ministry.

We are moving on by the grace of God Who has already chosen our Joshua. Our Joshua will be a different leader with different skill sets who has been prepared by God to lead this congregation into the future.






