And we were suffering with the blood-sucking bugs in our rooms every night, but your hired an exterminator for us to clean away all the bugs. Now we are sleeping good. We are so thankful to Jesus who brought wonderful people like you in our lives—we thank you from our hearts. Thank you so much for all of the Christmas gifts, food, medicines, shirts, and fruits you provided for us. We all appreciate you and love you so much.
