We are considering discontinuing this particular feature, so your responses will be important.

Important Anniversary:

This year marks the 20th Anniversary of the 9/11 attacks. Recently we have heard certain elected officials downplay the significance of 9/11 compared to more recent events. Twenty years ago, people vowed: "We will never forget." But some have.

Council has approved holding a "Commemorative Remembrance" on Saturday, 11 September 2021 during the precise time period of the attacks and their immediate aftermath.

My plan is to open the nave at 8.30 AM so that people may engage in prayer and contemplation of the terrible attack made upon all of us twenty years ago, and its victims.

A printed Timeline of the key events of that September morning will be distributed. On the minute of the major episodes-the strike on each tower and on the Pentagon; the crash of Flight 93; and the collapse of tower-will each be marked with a chime. Votive candles will be available for those who desire to light one as a gesture of solemn remembrance.

In addition, there will be a display in the narthex featuring certain items representative of that day and its aftermath.

There will be no music or singing, no readings or addresses. This is to be considered a time of solemn remembrance and personal prayer or reflecsuitable tion, for churched and secular people alike; the public will be invited via Messiah's digital sign. The time span corresponds to the events of that morning, which began at 8.46 AM and saw the final collapse at 10.28 AM.

Mark your calendars. We must not forget. +



The Atlantic Mission Region's annual fall Convocation is currently being planned to be held in person on **Friday**, **October 22 & Saturday**, **October 23** at Holy Cross ELC, Nazareth, PA.
