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Pastor's Page

In the first congregation conversation hosted by the Strategic Planning Committee on 15 May, someone asked how the "Prayer House" system works. It's time to explain anew for newer members, and to offer a review for everyone.

The "Prayer House" concept was initiated in order to foster members' participation in the ministry of intercessory prayer for others as part of our individual prayer discipline.

Those who choose to participate contact the parish office to register, and to select one of two methods of weekly notification of the updated "prayer list:"

Via email (make sure Robin has your valid email address); or

By picking up a printed copy at the Information Center in the narthex on Sunday morning. The prayer list is identical in either electronic or printed format.

The prayer list is the source for the names read in the gathered prayers of the congregation on Sunday mornings.

Because of the quantity of requests often received, a name is kept on the prayer list for three weeks. Names are usually submitted by congregation members. It is the responsibility of the person submitting a name to do several things:

First, check with the person to be named, or an <u>immediate</u> family member, to confirm that the person named grants permission for their name to appear on the list.

Second, notify the parish office, providing the correct spelling of the name and, if possible, the relationship between the person named, and the person submitting that name. Third, if the submitter wishes a name to be continued past three weeks, notify the parish office requesting an extension.

Fourth, if the person's circumstances have changed (for instance, improvement or death), notify the parish office of the change.

The nature of the person's need is not published, both to protect privacy and to avoid erroneous interpretation of information.

Those participating in the "Prayer House" ministry receive this information, and are encouraged to pray daily for each person named. If you are acquainted with the person, you are also welcome to call them to offer encouragement.

It is not necessary to inquire regarding the specifics of need in connection with anyone on the list. They are welcome to provide such information, but the Lord our God knows every detail of the lives of every person on earth. It is sufficient for our ministry to lift someone up before the Lord in prayer; God fills in the gaps better than we ever could.

In addition to praying for the persons on the Prayer List, I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to join me in an additional specific prayer ministry.

I pray my way through the parish directory, page by page, praying for each individual and/or family in the directory. I let the Holy Spirit guide me in this; some days I pray for only a few people; other days I might pray through an entire page.

The important thing is that we hold one another in prayer, daily, and also that we pray for our congregation, for brothers and sisters in other churches around the world, and for the mission of Christ in this broken world.

One of the signs that *agape* love is alive in us is our investment in lifting before God our brothers and sisters. You are welcome and encouraged to share in this ministry. +


