Pastor's Page

Please read this important information:

Congregation Council has had to take action in light of a \$12,000 deficit in contributions vs expenditures for the first quarter of 2018.

By the end of June, the Office Manager's hours will be reduced by 25%. To facilitate this change, Thursday office hours will be discontinued. There will be no public office hours on Thursdays.

Current public office hours will continue on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

The reduction in Robin's hours will also make necessary certain changes in Robin's work priorities. Please make your telephone calls to Robin as efficient as possible, to allow her sufficient time for her regular weekly duties within prescribed work hours.

We also ask committees to do as much work incommittee as possible, and keep Robin informed by notes or emails so that she can keep bulletin and Newsletter information current and complete.

Another change in light of circumstances is a reduction in Newsletter publication to an every-othermonth schedule. Beginning with this issue, the Newsletter will be published Jan/Feb, Mar/Apr, May/June, July/Aug, Sept/Oct, and Nov/Dec.

Each issue will become a "double issue" in regard to schedules, birthdays, Council summaries, and calendars. Please plan to keep your Newsletter for the duration of the coverage period so that you have complete schedule information.

We regret the necessity of these steps, but have no alternative, given fiscal realities. Even with these, we are on track to project nearly a \$50,000 shortfall in contributions compared to the Ministry Plan adopted by the congregation last November.

We appreciate the volunteers who have offered to clean the lavatories, worship and fellowship spaces at no cost but cleaning supplies. We appreciate everyone who is working on monthly Clean-up Days and who will sign up for grounds care this growing season. We appreciate everyone striving to give sacrificially and regularly to support the witness and ministries of the congregation.

Your regular and fervent prayers for the witness, ministries, and wellbeing of the congregation are also appreciated, and are very necessary.

I personally regret imposing a financial loss on Robin Harris and her family, and ask you to join me in praying that God will provide for their needs.

The fact that many congregations are in similar circumstances is small comfort as we experience these things, and it seems likely that more significant changes will soon have to be made as well. We are responsible to conduct ourselves, and manage what God has entrusted to us, in the most faithful manner possible. May God help us. +






April Congregation Council Meeting Highlights

The Messiah Congregation Council met on Tuesday, April 10, 2018.

- A discussion was held regarding the Easter Vigil format. It was decided to review the Vigil format after the Vigil in 2019.
- After comparing attendance patterns for the noon service on Maundy Thursday and the people attending, it was decided to eliminate the Maundy Thursday noon worship time and observe only the evening liturgy.
- Council was reminded that distracting conversations, especially those related to the business of the congregation, still occur on many Sundays prior to worship. Council members can set an appropriate example by declining to participate in such ill-timed interactions, which will help the people remember that the time before worship is for spiritual preparation to come before God. Other kinds of conversation should take place after worship, or at a different time entirely.
- Memorial funds will be used to purchase 18 six-foot tables for the Fellowship Hall. These tables will be lighter to handle.
- Our volunteer custodian is no longer able to continue this ministry due to work obligations. A letter of thanks will be sent to him. An advertisement will be placed for a replacement volunteer, or an individual willing to accept the position of Facilities Services Contractor for 5 hours per week.
- Sign-up sheets for the Veggie-Table meal on April 29th and the trip to the Choo-Choo Barn on April 21st are on the Information Center.


