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Pastor's Page

You may have heard, or read, something about the new PA laws going into effect this July which re-

As part of our overall efforts to protect children and comply with the laws, we are making a change in policy:

When a child under the age of 14 must leave the nave during worship, that child must be accompanied by a parent or adult guardian until he/she returns to the nave.

Since the church doors are not locked during worship, we must insure that children are not placed in a vulnerable situation. The simplest way to do this is to ask parents to stay with their child. We appreciate our parents' understanding about this. I also ask everyone to be understanding when a parent must step out of worship to accompany their child.

We are also working on another alteration in our practice, this one entirely constructive.

Pastor, Christian Education committee members, Council and interested church members are teaming up to build a new approach to Christian faith development.

Rather than separating

children from their families to learn about the Bible, Christian teachings, and discipleship, we are preparing to offer an integrated learning approach for all ages together, especially for parents and children to share together.

Our vision is to offer resources and experiences that will foster growing understanding and confidence in matters of faith, and growing thankfulness and joy in response to God's goodness, that will be every-day and life-long, and will let parents and children actually **talk together** about God, what God has done (and is doing) for us, and how to relate to Him and to one another as people of faith.

The old Sunday School model, reflecting the structures of public education (and originally established for the practical education of unschooled children) no longer works. Nor, we think, should it be used.

Parents and children are separated much of the time by work or school responsibilities, activities, and social circles (including "texting"). The Church should bring people together. This is one of our goals. If you would like to help bring the vision to fulfillment, please speak to me; your help is welcome.+ Summer vacation is a great break for everyone. But the needs of the church never take a vacation. Please remember your offerings, gifts and tithes to Messiah when you are on vacation. Thank you.

The Messiah Congregation Council met on Tuesday, June 9, 2015.

- Eight members were in attendance. One member was excused.
- Devotions were led by Teenie Batdorf.
- Ruth DeLong was appointed to be the delegate from Messiah at the National Convocation of the NALC to be held in Dallas, TX on August 13-14, 2015.
- Council unanimously passed a child protection policy for Messiah pending any changes to the new child protection law by the state. This policy may be viewed on our website.
- Due to the new state child protection law, we would ask that any child 14 and under be accompanied by a parent if he/she leaves the sanctuary during the service.
- Our first Faith and Fellowship pot luck brunch will be held on Sunday, August 16. More information can be found on page 3 of this newsletter and in future bulletins.
- Council approved a motion to have Wert Bookbinding cover the Palm Lutheran Church logo on the LBWs (hymnals) we purchased from them. Cost of covering the logo is \$0.55 per book. We have approximately 300 hymnals that need to be covered. We will use these hymnals as replacements for the damaged ones we currently use.
- Congregation Council will not meet in July. The next scheduled meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 11, 2015.

Pecan Pie Cake Recipe

Deb Lutz made this cake for the Pentecost birthday celebration, and she had many requests for the recipe. So, here you are—enjoy!

1 box yellow cake or butter cake mix 1 egg 1/2 C. melted butter

1-1/2 C. light corn syrup
3 eggs
1/2 C. dark brown sugar, packed
1 tsp. vanilla
1-1/2 C. chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 325°. Mix cake mix, 1 egg and the melted butter until well blended (batter will be like dough). Reserve 2/3 C. batter. Spread/ press the remainder of the batter into a greased 13x9" pan and bake for 15 minutes or until lightly browned.

Mix reserved batter with the corn syrup, 3 eggs, brown sugar, vanilla and pecans. Pour this mixture on top of the cake and bake for an additional 50-60 minutes.
